Class Description:

Beginning and Continuing Torchon and Bucks Point, *Holly Van Sciver*

Students of all levels are invited to join this class. Choose from Torchon, a geometric straight lace characterized by diamonds, rectangles, triangles and Torchon ground; or Bucks Point, characterized by a delicate grounds, picots and designs outlined by a gimp thread. Beginning students in each lace will learn the ground, design features, headside and footside techniques. Although diagrams will be supplied to beginners, the underlying theory of each lace will be taught so students will learn to "read" the pricking and eventually work the pattern without the use of diagrams. Continuing students in Torchon, Bucks Point and Lester are invited to join this class to advance their skills.
