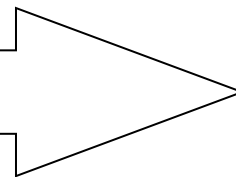

Classes

Lace Knitting with **Michelle Chase**

Class Size: Max 6 students

Lace knitting looks complicated, but it really isn't. Lace is simply holes created in fabric, by knitting increases and decreases. Complex looking results can be achieved by anyone who has the patience and perseverance to try. In this class, you will knit a lace scarf from both written directions and charts.

Basic knitting skills (casting on and off, knit and purl stitch) are a prerequisite for this course.

You will need to bring 400 yards of a fingering weight yarn that feels soft next to your skin and a pair of #8 knitting needles (straight or circular). Choose a solid color (not variegated) yarn. Stitch markers and a smooth small yarn for lifelines (crochet cotton or dental floss). Pencil and paper for taking notes.

Bobbin Lace Pendant (Intermediate Bobbin Lace) with **Tonya Little** Class Size: Max 18

Class Fee: \$13.00 paid directly to Tonya

This class is geared for all levels of bobbin lacemakers and is very simple. The goal is to create a wearable piece of jewelry quickly so that you can show off your lace. It requires only 12 pair of bobbins, each bobbin wound with at least 18 inches of DMC Diamant metallic thread or equivalent, a pillow, and basic lacemaking supplies. (If you have difficulty finding the thread, there will be some available at the class.)

Introduction to Tatting with **Arlene Medder**

Class Size: Max 5 students

Class Fee: None

Want to learn the basics of tatting? Tatting involves mastery of one knot and builds from there. In this class, I will teach how to make the knot and how to use it to create rings, picots, and joins. And then how to add a second thread to make chains. Shuttle and thread provided.
